KUALA LUMPUR: The Rotary Club of Pudu has donated 20 wheelchairs to the Ampang Hospital under the Club's Wheelchair for Poor Patients project.

The project was officially launched by Member of Parliament for Pandan, Dato' Seri Ong Tee Keat, at the Shangri-La Hotel Kuala Lumpur recently.

Initiated by Rotary Club of Pudu past president Ng Sim Bee, who noticed the shortage of wheelchairs in the hospital, the project was aimed at easing the burden of the hospital's poor patients with mobility problems brought on by illness or an accident.

Ampang Hospital, the many government

hospitals, has set up a department of Medical Social Works to assist poor patients who are without families or means of paying the most basic of medical care.

This department is entrusted to assign the donated wheelchairs to the respective poor and needy patients who require them.

In conjunction with the presentation, there was also a talk on thalassemia by Dr Jamesle Salleh, a consultant haematologist at Ampang Hospital.

Ong urged Malaysians to do more to help others. Citing the recent Japanese quake and tsunami disaster, Ong said:

"We should find out what their needs are so that we can help better."

Ong presented the wheelchair donation to Dr Rusli Mohamed Salleh, the deputy director (Medical) of Ampang Hospital.
